Undergraduate Application to TESOL Program

All students must apply for admission to the teacher education program even if they have already been admitted to the University. **Please note that admission to the programs is competitive, not automatic.** Matriculation in the program and approval of the Undergraduate Director and the TESOL Program Director is required to register for education classes.

Requirements: Applicants must be LIN majors and have a minimum GPA of 3.0 overall and 3.0 in the major. If students have completed more than 12 credits at Stony Brook, admission decisions will be based on their Stony Brook grade point average. Students are required to have taken LIN 101 (Human Language), LIN 201 (Phonetics), and/or LIN 311 (Syntax), completing them with a C or higher, prior to applying for the TESOL Teacher Education Program. These requirements also hold for registration for LIN 375 and LIN 449.

Application Instructions: To ensure that their graduation is not delayed, undergraduates should apply no later than spring of their sophomore year or their fifth semester. Applicants must meet the Director of TESOL Teacher Preparation and Certification for a consultation about program requirements and meet with the Undergraduate Director of the Linguistics Department for a consultation about degree progress and planning. Their signatures on this form confirm that these consultations have taken place. Applicants must submit the completed form, along with an unofficial copy of their transcript(s) from all colleges and universities previously attended, to the Director of TESOL Teacher Preparation and Certification.

After receiving notice of acceptance to the program, applicants must declare a Teacher Preparation option by submitting the "*Declaration of Major/Minor Form*" in SOLAR.

Applications are accepted at any time, but admission decisions will be made shortly after the following dates: Last day of classes in fall and spring semesters The first day of classes in fall and spring semesters
