Course Waivers: Certain required courses may be waived for students showing an exceptional background in linguistics or TESOL. Applications for such waivers must be made in writing to the department. Regardless of the waived courses, 30 credits must be earned to receive a degree.

For certification, applicants must pass the NYS ESOL CST exam.
