Five-Year Accelerated BA/MA Program with TESOL Certification

The Linguistics Department offers a five-year accelerated BA/MA degree program with TESOL certification. Upon completion of the program, graduates will hold a Bachelor's degree in Linguistics, New York State teaching certification in TESOL, and a Master's degree in TESOL. The combined program will provide students the opportunity to complete these requirements sooner than students who complete the programs sequentially. The accelerated program is restricted to students with an outstanding undergraduate record who are expected to excel in the graduate program.¹
