1. Let X and Y be discrete random variables with joint probability mass function

$$f(x,y) = \frac{C}{(x+y-1)(x+y)(x+y+1)}, \quad x,y = 1,2,3,\dots$$

Find the constant C and the marginal mass function of X.

2. A factory has produced n machines, each of which is defective with probability p. For each machine, a test is performed. Suppose a machine is defective, the test will detect the defect with probability δ . Let X be the number of defective machines and Y be the number of machines detected as defective. Compute E[X|Y].

3. Let $X_{(1)} \leq X_{(2)} \leq \ldots \leq X_{(n)}$ be the order statistics of X_1, X_2, \ldots, X_n , where X_i 's are i.i.d. uniform random variables between 0 and 1. Find the probability density function of $X_{(n)} - X_{(1)}$.
