1. Scholarship Program:

2. Eligibility:

To be eligible for a scholarship from the AHEPA Educational Foundation (AEF), applicants must certify that they meet Criteria A and B, along with either Criteria C or D, in addition to Criteria A. This structured approach ensures that the foundation supports students who not only excel academically but also embody the principles of Hellenism. AEF is dedicated to recognizing and assisting students of Hellenic descent, as well as Phil-Hellenes, who demonstrate a commitment to the ideals promoted by the Greek heritage. It is essential for applicants to maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 to qualify for consideration. This requirement reinforces the foundation's commitment to academic excellence while also aiding students in financial need. Interested candidates should thoroughly review the specific eligibility requirements and prepare their applications accordingly during the open application period from January 2nd to March 31st.

- A. To be eligible for a scholarship from the AHEPA Educational Foundation, applicants (MUST BE ACTIVE AND CURRENT YEAR PAID MEMBERS) of anyone of the AHEPA Family (AHEPA, Daughters of Penelope, Sons of Pericles, or Maids of Athena)! They, must also be of Hellenic descent or identify as Phil-Hellenes, emphasizing the foundation's commitment to community involvement and the promotion of Hellenic values. - B. A high school graduate or a high school senior planning to attend, full time, an Accredited College or University During the 2025 academic year; or
- C. A college student currently attending an Accredited College or University and will continue to attend, full time, During the 2025 academic year; or
- D. A College or University graduate planning to attend, full time, a graduate or professional degree program During the 2025 academic year

Note: A scholarship recipient is limited ONLY to be AWARDED (1) scholarship EVER as an, Undergraduate student and as a Graduate student!!!
