

Dr. Ram Raju is Senior Vice President and Community Health Investment Officer for Northwell Health. He is the former president and CEO of NYC Health + Hospitals, and CEO for the Cook County (Illinois) Health and Hospitals System, and he served as vice-chair of the Greater New York Hospital Association. He serves on the boards of numerous city, state and national health care organizations.

Dr. Raju received his medical education from Madras Medical College and continued his training in England. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons. He earned an MBA from the University of Tennessee and CPE from the American College of Physician Executives.
