The University Senate represents over 2800 faculty and 3300 professional staff as well as undergraduate and graduate students. Its charge is to provide faculty/staff/student input into University decision-making through a structure that involves over 150 elected senators. The Senate meets collectively once a month, during which the University President, the Provost, and the Vice President for the Health Sciences address its membership and are immediately available to discuss issues affecting the entire campus.

Key work in the Senate is accomplished through its various Standing Committees, each containing members elected from various representative constituencies. The charge and the representation for each of these committees is described on the University Senate <a href="website">website</a>. Standing Committees report to the Senate Executive Committee which meets weekly to oversee Senate operations.

There are many opportunities to become involved with the University Senate. I urge you to consider serving the Stony Brook University by volunteering yourself for one of these open positions, or by nominating a trusted colleague.
